Subject: **Expressions of interest for Appointment to Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee**

The Martha's Vineyard Joint Transportation Committee (JTC) is seeking persons interested in serving on its Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). In addition to offering advice to the JTC, the BPAC promotes awareness of and solutions to bicycling and pedestrian mobility independent of the JTC.

The BPAC is comprised of nine members and two alternates appointed to staggered three-year terms that expire at the end of April. The group meets (the last six years virtually, via Zoom) from 6:00 to 7:00pm on the second Tuesday of each month. The meetings are public and posted on the MVC's website calendar.

This year, the JTC will fill two BPAC seats. Terms of two BPAC members expire this April. One of these members has expressed interest in reappointment. The full terms run through April 2029.

In filling these BPAC seats, the JTC is interested in having a group that is broadly representative of the island, however. Attached is a list of the present BPAC membership and which seats are to be filled in April.

Expressions of interest will be compiled for review and consideration by the JTC at its April meeting when it is expected to make appointments to fill the positions. Candidates not selected will form a pool from which the JTC may draw to fill BPAC vacancies that may occur prior to its annual late winter solicitation of interest for appointment to the BPAC.
